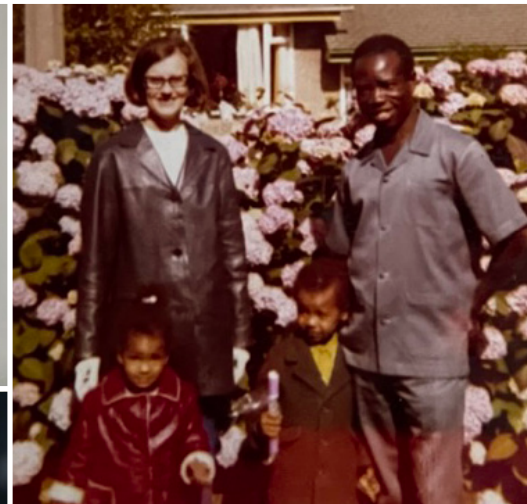

1 Corinthians 15:50-58

This is what I'm saying, my dear family. Flesh and blood can't inherit God's kingdom; decay can't inherit undecaying life. Look! I'm telling you a mystery. We won't all sleep; we're all going to be changed—in a flash, at the blink of an eye, at the last trumpet. This is how it will be, you see: the trumpet's going to sound, the dead will be raised undecaying, and we're going to be changed. This decaying body must put on the undecaying one; this dying body must put on immortality. When the decaying puts on the undecaying, and the dying puts on the undying, then the saying that has been written will come true:

Death is swallowed up in victory!
Death, where's your victory gone?
Death, where's your sting gone?

The "sting" of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law.
But thank God!
He gives us the victory, through our Lord Jesus the Messiah.
