**CATHEDRAL TIMELINE** Please take the time to have a look at the Cathedral timeline display that has recently been installed along the western terrace. It charts the history of the Cathedral, right from the arrival of the first Christians in the 7th century to the present day, and includes lots of fascinating historical information and interesting photographs. Our Director of Education, Maggie Myers, has developed the timeline with support from our Events & Marketing Officer, Phil Lickley. The display has been made possible as a result of the building works currently taking place at Kala Sangam, which will re-open as the Bradford Arts Centre in 2025, making use of the scaffold security hoarding. We are grateful to Kala Sangam/ Bradford Arts Centre for working with us. The Cathedral has had to make no financial contribution to the display which we hope will be of great interest to visitors. The display will remain in situ until mid-2025.
