On other staffing matters, our new Head of Fundraising, Liz Purchase, started work on 09/12/2024, and in the new year we will also be joined by Robin Morton, Section Lead & Lay Clerk, and William Campbell as Sub-Organist & Assistant Director of Music. Both have made significant contributions to the Cathedral's musical life and leave with our thanks and best wishes for the future.
