GRAND APPLICATION SUCCESS We are delighted that our grant application to the Cathedral Sustainability Fund (CSF) has been successful, resulting in a grant of £133,178. Applying to the CSF is a competitive process, so a positive outcome was not guaranteed; that we have been awarded the full amount we applied for, is a fantastic result. The funding is for 3.5 years, and it will enable us to employ a professional safeguarding officer and work towards the Church of England's National Safeguarding Standards. We will share further news about this in coming weeks.
