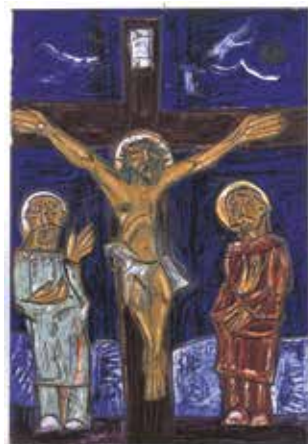

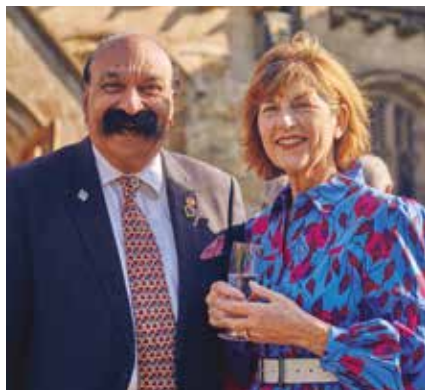

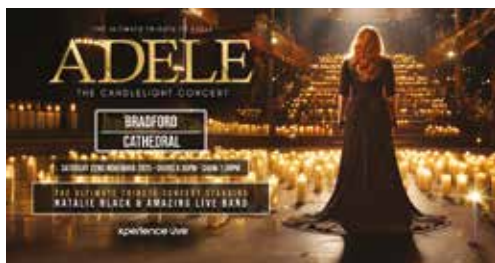

We are seen as pioneers in our commitment to the environment by other cathedrals and faith communities.

This year we mark Fairtrade Fortnight with the **Fairtrade Breakfast** on Sunday

28th September, before the 10:30am service and, on Sunday 5th October, a **Big Brew** following our 10:30am service.

We also mark **Harvest on Sunday 5th October**, where we will celebrate God's good gifts to us as the intercultural community that we are. We will share our traditions of marking this season from around the world and stand with brothers and sisters for whom harvest time is uncertain and, at times devastating.

Ever wondered what's in a church, masjid, mandir or gurdwara? The Bradford Faith Trail offers a unique opportunity to discover a little bit about Muslim, Hindu, Sikh and Christian (Roman Catholic and Church of England) faith buildings, about the faiths within and how they link into Bradford's local community culture and faith heritage. Our Trail also takes us through Little Germany, where we pause to consider Bradford's Jewish history and heritage.
