UPDATE ON THE CATHEDRAL'S PRECINCT access improvements project, 'Welcoming In'. We are delighted to have confirmation of a grant of £30,000 from the Garfield Weston Foundation. Their grant, along with other funders' support, will enable us to improve our welcome into the Cathedral. Project plans include urgent repairs to the main pathway to the North Porch, installation of new lighting across the precinct, the extension of existing handrails and the installation of new one. Fundraising is continuing, but with the news about this significant grant we are confident we will reach our target.
